Things We Focused On This Month:

This month, we continued to support the children's growth through a variety of structured and play-based learning opportunities. Some of our focus areas included:

- **Table Activities:** Children practiced important early learning and fine motor skills through activities such as tracing, cutting, matching, puzzles, and simple crafts. These activities helped build attention, hand strength, and independence.
- **Sensory and Motor Exploration:** We encouraged children to explore a variety of sensory-rich experiences, including painting, water play, and kinetic sand activities. These experiences supported creativity, sensory processing, and fine motor development while providing lots of opportunities for fun and discovery.
- **Following Daily Routines:** We worked on helping children become more familiar with the daily schedule and classroom expectations.
