This first month has focused on assessment, connection, and building comfort. We have been supporting children to:

- Get familiar with the environment and daily routines
- Build trust with staff and peers
- Explore different play areas and activities
- Begin participating in simple group routines
- We understand that transitions can take time, and each child is adjusting at their own pace.

LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT FOCUS



This month we focused on:

- Following simple instructions (e.g., “sit,” “come,” “clean up”)
- Responding to name and adult cues
- Engaging in play (cause-and-effect toys, sensory play, simple turn-taking)
- Transitioning between activities with support
- Early communication (gestures, sounds, or words)

These early skills help set the stage for more independent participation in group learning.
